Addendum: January 26, 2018

The following is a representation of the clarification that was requested for the Landscaping and Lawn Maintenance Bid that was released on January 10, 2018.

- 1.) Prevailing Wage: Prevailing wage is required per the Department of Labor definition. Generally speaking, the maintenance of the lawn does not require prevailing wage. However, installation of any materials could be categorized under prevailing wage and thus, must meet the requirements, should those services be needed.
- 2.) Combination Bid: Although the bids can be submitted with spraying services independent of the mowing, the District's obligation is to identify the most reasonable, responsive and qualified bidder. The District identifies a complete bid with all services as a more qualified and responsive bid. The scope of the work does allow for subcontractor work, provided that the subcontractor information is disclosed up front and the subcontractor meets all of the necessary safety and security requirements of the bid. The use of a subcontractor, if required, could ensure a more complete bid.

All bid are to be submitted no later the 10:00am on Wednesday February 7, 2018 per the bid specifications.
