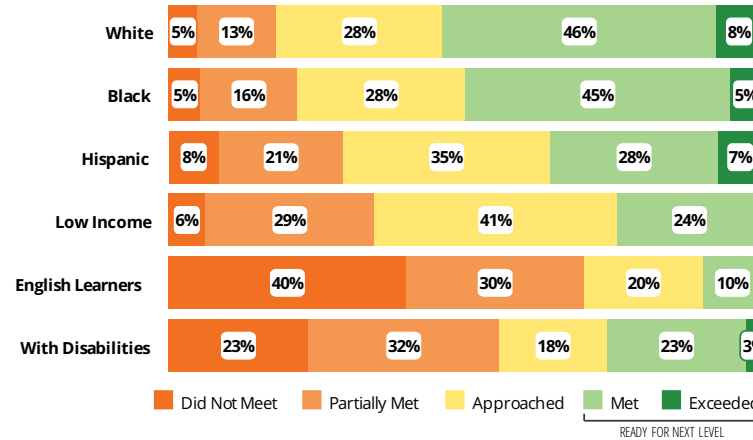
Academic Success

Success by Student Group

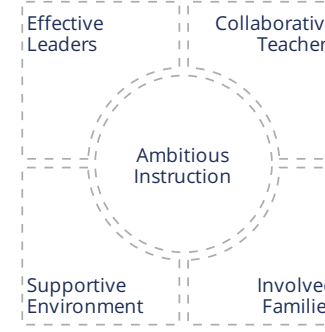
This display shows PARCC performance levels for each student group. No data is shown for groups with fewer than 10 students.

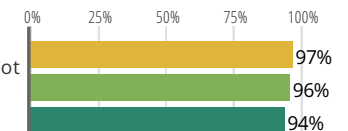

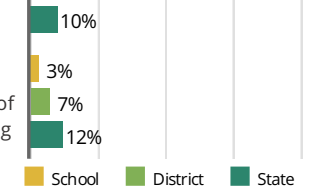


Chronic Truancy Rate

School Highlights

Academic Courses

Chelsea School embraces the developing independence of the intermediate learner within an academically challenging and socially supportive learning environment. The instructional approaches and programs include differentiated instruction, cooperative learning, integrated ELA curricular units, math, science, social science, and character development.

Physical Education, Health and Wellness

The Chelsea physical education program emphasizes life-long fitness and making healthy life-style choices. Each day the students are actively engaged in a variety of sports, dance, and exercise activities. The curriculum also includes instruction on nutrition, diet, and life safety. The Student Recyclers Program is facilitated by the PE staff.

Other Programs and Activities

Chelsea Intermediate School partners with our local police department to provide multiple safety assemblies to our students, including an Internet Safety Assembly, Halloween Safety Assembly, and the DARE Program which is provided to our fifth graders for nine weeks each year.

School Awards

Chelsea School has raised over \$550,000 for the American Heart Association. We are ranked number two in the nation and number one among the Midwest Affiliates for our successful Jump Rope for Heart events.

Career Development Courses and Programs

Chelsea curriculum and programs are tailored to support students in preparing for college readiness and career development. Fostering literate citizens, problem solvers, collaborative thinkers, and future leaders is embedded in the activities of the core curriculum and enhanced in the weekly Encore classes of library, STEM, art, PE, and music.

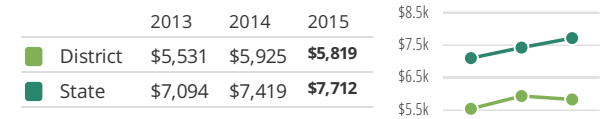
Chelsea School staff includes three social workers, three speech pathologists, two reading interventionists, two math interventionist, one school nurse, one school psychologist, one Title I teacher, 1 ESL teacher, and an entire staff dedicated to meeting the needs of all our students, including IEP support services and gifted instruction.

Facilities

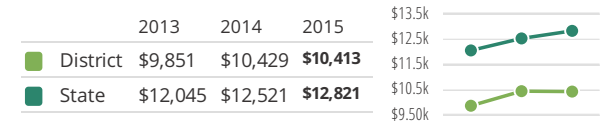
Chelsea has mobile computer labs, 3 science labs, a library, 3 gyms, 2 instrumental music rooms, and a performance stage. Classrooms are enhanced with Smartboard technology, ELMOs, and computers. Students have access to a full-size track, 2 playgrounds, an OT/PT classroom, and a sensory room. The administrative offices are near to students and staff.

District Finance

Instructional Spending per Pupil includes only the activities directly dealing with the teaching of students or the interaction between teachers and students.

Educator Measures
