PHYSICAL AND DENTAL EXAMS

Physicals, required immunizations, and dental exams are required of all incoming 6th graders, and any students entering Frankfort Schools for the first time. Please turn them into the nurse's office as soon as possible.

Sport physicals are required for all sports team participation at Hickory Creek Middle School, including try-outs. Physicals expire 395 days from the date they were obtained. The 6th grade physical may be used in lieu of a sports physical for 6th grade only.

MEDICATION

All medication (including over the counter, i.e. Tylenol, Motrin) must be prescribed by a licensed prescriber. A written order on the District's Medication Authorization Form must be completed by the student's physician and signed by the parent(s)/guardian(s).

Inhalers prescribed to treat asthma do NOT require a physician's signature on the Medication Authorization Form. However, a prescription label must be attached to the bottom of the form and signed by the parent(s)/guardian(s).

GUIDELINES FOR KEEPING YOUR CHILD AT HOME

Fever of 100 degrees- keep home for at least 24 hours after being fever free without the aid of medication

Vomiting or Diarrhea- keep home for 24 hours after last episode

Rash- it will be assumed contagious, a doctor's note will be needed to return to school

Strep throat- must be on an antibiotic at least 24 hours before returning to school and be fever free

Pinkeye- need to be seen by physician and on an antibiotic for 24 hours before returning to school

Live head lice

Heavy cold- any excessive drainage, coughing, and or sneezing
