<u>PALEOLITHIC</u>	<u>NEOLITHIC</u>
Men hunted animals for food.	They learned how to domesticate animals.
Had early forms of technology.	First villages, Jericho & Catal Huyuk
Old Stone Age	New Stone Age
Lived mostly in caves & tent-like shelters	Used plants for food.
Cave paintings thought to have religious meaning or to have a good hunt.	Later became known as the Bronze Age (used bronze tools)
Nomads (hunter-gatherers); travel in small clans of no more than 30 people	Began to stay in one place because of <b>FARMING REVOLUTION!!!!!!!!!!</b>
Discovered/tamed fire-cooking food, warmth, scare wild animals, smoked meat, light the darkness	Started using copper for tools, then went to bronze- also made better farming tools (sickle)
Women cared for children & gathered nuts & berries.	Men herded, farmed, took care of the crops, & protected the villages.
Men hunted for the meat using strategies like running	Women did household tasks.

<p>Spoken language- no more grunting</p>	<p>Mud brick houses &amp; places to worship.</p>
<p>ICE AGE- taming fire important to their SURVIVAL!; forced them to adapt to survive this and beyond.</p>	<p>Specialization- making pottery, weaving cloth, carved objects out of wood</p>
<p>Used stone (flint) to make simple tools; crushed stones for painting</p>	<p>Permanent housing, staying in one place creating a secure environment.</p>
