A Word from the Office

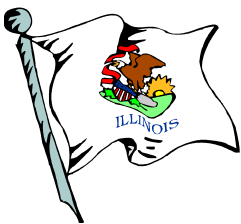
Grand Prairie Families,

Kindergarten Registration

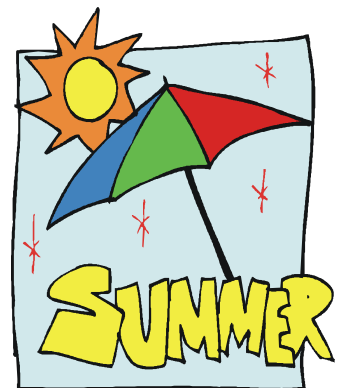
