At its regular meeting held 15 February 2010 the Board of Education:

- Written reports were submitted from Principals, Director of Special Education, Director of Technology and Instructional Coordinators relevant to Strategic Plan.
- Heard a report on the Lincoln Way Special Education District 843 meeting held on 26 January 2010.
- Heard from Assistant Superintendent Curt Saindon an update on hiring of summer help and developments of the FY10/11 budget.
- Heard from Superintendent Tom Hurlburt on developing an Administrator Handbook and consideration of adding Full Day Kindergarten while offering families extended day as well.
- Approved to remain with our current student insurance carrier, Markel Insurance, Naperville, Illinois for the 2010/2011 school year.
- Approved the distribution of the Discipline Handbook for 2010/2011 year as presented.
- Accepted the school calendar for 2010/2011 school year as presented.
- Accepted the fee breakdown for the 2010/2011 school year as presented.
- Approved the current Freedom of Information Rate Charge of \$.15 per page for the 2010/2011 school year.
- Authorized the administration to fill three (3) full time equivalent (FTE) positions for clerical summer helpers for the summer of 2010.
- Authorized the administration to fill two (2) full time equivalent (FTE) positions for technology summer helpers for the summer of 2010.
- Authorized the administration to fill nine (9) full time equivalent (FTE) positions for custodial/maintenance summer helpers for the summer of 2010.
- Approved to prepare an RFP for a technology lease for Hickory Creek Middle School.
