At its regular meeting held 19 October 2009, the Board of Education:

- Approved the superintendent's goals as presented.
- Recognized Rachel Binole for being a finalist for the Golden Apple award, Michelle Sommer for receiving Star in the Classroom award, and Katie Duff for receiving Those Who Excel Education award.
- Reviewed reports from Principals, Director of Special Education Services, Director of Technology and Instructional Coordinators relevant to current and upcoming projects.
- Heard from Superintendent Thomas Hurlburt that he recommends putting a virtual backpack on the district website which would conserve paper as well as cut back on the number of flyers sent home with students and having board member emails on the district server. Mr. Hurlburt stated that the Will County Health Department will be using Hickory Creek as a site to give H1N1 vaccinations on November 4 and December 2 from 3:30 – 9:30 p.m and also December 30<sup>th</sup> if needed.
- Heard from Board Member Brian Klene on the Special Education Meeting of Lincoln-Way District 843 on 22 September 2009.
- Heard a report on the latest Frankfort Township Planning meeting.
- A Freedom of Information request was received for names of any Contractors doing any installation, alteration and/or service-maintenance work on heating, ventilation, air conditioning, and exhaust systems.
- Heard a presentation by the administration team focusing on the instructional strategies behind the data from the ISAT.
- Heard from Assistant Superintendent Curt Saindon on the latest discussion concerning construction. ICI and FGM recapped the financial status of the Grand Prairie and Chelsea additions to date.
