- **Progress Reports**

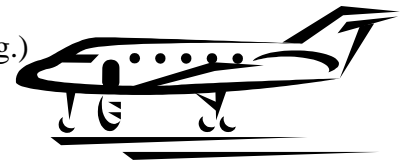
Each Jets teacher will be passing out progress reports on a regular basis. You will be asked to sign these, and have your child return the notice to school for credit. Please ask your child for these updates, as it helps you to understand your child's academic progress in seventh grade.

- **Organization**

Each core teacher has a binder requirement for class. This is to help develop organizational skills in each of our students. Seventh graders are expected to keep all papers for an entire unit in the binder. This portfolio of work makes it easy for families to monitor progress and share curriculum.

- **No gum is allowed in school.** Consequences are as follows:

1. First Incident/Verbal warning (There will be only one verbal warning.)
2. Second, Third, and Fourth Incidents/One lunch detention for each
3. Fifth Incident and Beyond/One after-school detention for each



- **Students are expected to report to each class on time.** Consequences are as follows for each core class:

1. First Incident/Verbal warning
2. Second Incident/Parent Contact
3. Third Incident/Lunch Detention

- **Student work is expected in its entirety at the start of each class on the day it is due.** Late work will be accepted for partial credit on the following day. A parent signature on a late sheet is required to turn in late work.
