

8th GRADE TEAM POLICIES 2009-2010 School Year

*The following rules are the policies for all eighth grade **CORE** classes.*

HOMEWORK:

- Homework is expected to be in on time. Late homework will not receive full credit.
- If a student accumulates three zeroes there will be parental notification.
- If a student is consistently late with homework in multiple classes, a parent conference will be called to work out further interventions.
- "OOPS" plan: We all make mistakes; therefore, the eighth grade teachers have issued each student three "OOPS" passes for the **first trimester**. Two passes will be given for the second trimester and one for the final grading period. This allows a student to come to any **CORE** class three times without homework and no penalty will be administered as long as the completed assignment is handed in the next day with the "OOPS" pass. If homework is one day late, they must give up one pass; two days late two passes and so on.
- These passes are the responsibility of the individual student. If they are lost, they will not be reissued and are not transferable.
- Any student with passes left at the end of a trimester will be given five points per pass to be used as **extra credit** in any CORE class. "OOPS" passes expire at the end of each trimester.

STUDENT ABSENCES:

- When a student is absent he/she will be given one day for every day absent to make up any missing work. If a student is out one day, they will get one extra day upon return to make up the work; two days out, two days to complete the make up and so on.
- It is the **student's responsibility** to find out what work they have missed.

TARDIES:

- Any student entering a teacher's classroom after the bell without a pass will be considered tardy.
- We will abide by the policy established in the discipline handbook.
 - 1st offense - student will receive a warning.
 - 2nd offense - parent will be contacted.
 - 3rd offense - student will receive a detention.

GUM and CANDY:

- The 8th grade core teachers will not tolerate any gum or candy in their classrooms.
- If a student is found to have gum or candy in a classroom they will be given consequences according to the teacher's classroom rules.
