Purpose:

The purpose of this program is to provide additional math assistance to all HCMS students. The program has been funded by Frankfort Education Foundation for the last 5 years. The students will be given the opportunity to attend homework assistance that will occur Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday until 3:30 p.m. This will allow students the extra opportunities to help build and develop their math concepts and skills to help create more success in their math program.

Monday after school will be for the Pre-Algebra students, only.

Tuesday after school will be for Algebra Part 1 (7.1 and 8.1), only.

Thursday after school will be for Algebra Part 2 (8.2), Honors Seventh Grade, and ATA, only.

Procedures and Expectations:

- Students will attend on the day of their math level only

Mondays-Pre-Algebra

Tuesdays-Algebra Part 1 (7.1 & 8.1)

Thursdays-Algebra Part 2 (8.2) & Honors Seventh Grade and ATA

- Students will report to the Cafetorium at 2:20 p.m. with their necessary math materials.
- A current assignment to work on or a past assignment that needs to be reviewed or revisited must be in the student's hand.
- Students should have signed up for the 3:45 p.m. activity bus or have a car ride arranged so they are picked up at 3:30 p.m.
- Students must leave at the designated time 3:30 p.m. (car rider or 3:45 p.m. bus rider). If the parent is not present before 3:40 p.m. the student will be required to ride the 3:45 p.m. activity bus home. If you are planning to attend a school sporting or other event, you must go home and then come back to the school.
- Students will not be allowed to go back to their locker.
- Students may bring a snack to eat and water to drink.
- Students are expected to have appropriate school and classroom behavior. Students who do not abide by this expectation will be asked to call home and be picked up.

Our goal is to continually help students become mathematically independent in their skills and comprehension.
