<p>Presentation Did the presenter speak clearly? Did the presenter engage the audience? Presenter may not have spoken loudly enough to be heard and clearly understood by class. Presentation had some strong moments but did not fully engage class.	Presenter spoke clearly and loudly enough to be easily heard and understood. Also, presenter did an excellent job of engaging the class. Preparation showed.
