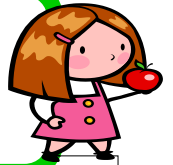

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Our Learning This Week:

Reading: Students were introduced to reading mats and are going to decorate them next week! Students also were able to practice building stamina for reading to self and partner reading. They will continue to build stamina each day. Our year long goal is 20 minutes. Students have been practicing reading at their tables. Once we master 20 minutes, they can start moving around the room!

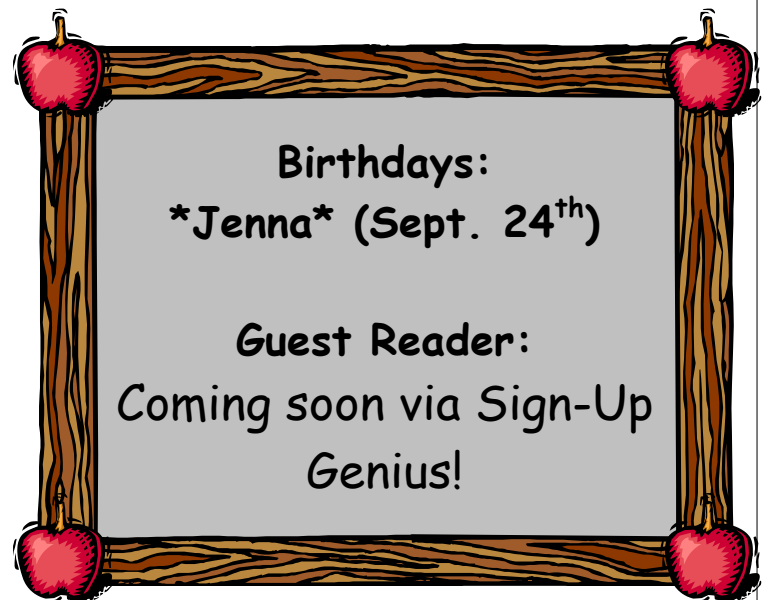
Writing: Students have official A and B carpet partners established for their carpet spot. A and B partners are used so that the partners can turn and talk during writing. Students learned about the touch/tell, sketch, and write method to help them foster their great ideas about a small moment in their lives!

Math: We have been working hard on learning about number bonds by finding two parts to equal 5, 6, and 7 as a whole. As a reminder, our homework expectation is that students log on and complete one lesson on Zearn each night, unless an extra practice worksheet is sent home. Keep practicing on Zearn for more help with math! Each lesson is on there (1-24) so students can work at his/her own pace! Once we move to module 2, I will update the lessons!

Skills to work on at home:



A "good fit" book is one that is not too easy and not too hard. Students can also be practicing addition math facts at home. Begin with +0 and +1. Once your child has mastered those with immediate recall, then progress to +2, +3, and so on. Students can keep logging onto Zearn nightly to complete a lesson. Students can also log on to Raz-Kids. I will be updating his/her appropriate level. They can listen to Raz-Kids at home, but we will also be implementing it as a listening to reading center soon!
