I Can Statements: I can show what number is needed to add to another number to make 10. I can show how the numbers 11-19 are made up of ten ones and more ones. I can quickly add to 5. I can show addition. I can add to solve word problems.

Showing different ways to make the same sum up to 10.

Showing what number is needed to add to another number to make the sum of ten.

Practice addition word problems and quickly adding up to 5.

Review: Understanding that numbers 11-19 are made up of 1 ten and more ones.

Vocab.-plus sign, minus sign, equal sign, sum, part, whole, take away

***Decompose**- whole = part + part

***Compose**- part + part = whole

SHARED READING

I can retell a story I've heard including key details. I can identify characters, settings, and major events in a story (with help).

With the use of Tacky books, we have been revisiting character development, as well as story features (characters, setting, sequence of events). You can discuss these features with your child at home, as well.

You can also have the kids retell the stories that you read at home. It's important that they can tell what happened in sequence starting at the beginning. We use the words First, Then, Next, and Last when retelling a story.

Review: Making Connections-The idea is that when we connect what we read to our own lives and to other books, we enrich our reading experience. Please have the kids make connections at home too!

Read Alouds- we have been enjoying reading non-fiction books and looking for interesting facts.
