**Math:** This week in math, students took their mid-module 2 assessments. These will be going home soon, so please check for it in your child's folder! Right now, we are working on subtracting using 10 and one other number. For example, 10 and 6 is 16, so students might do  $16-5=11$ . Students were exposed to this type of subtraction this week, so they are still learning about subtracting bigger numbers instead of what they have been taught so far. (Subtracting or adding from 10).
