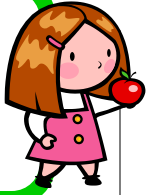

- I CAN use words such as first, next, and then to tell events in order and include actions, thoughts, and feelings.

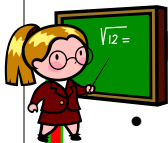
Math: Place Value
