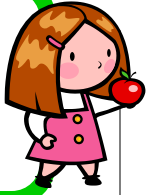

## Reading: Informational Questioning

- We will read: Ice Bear and various nonfiction short stories.
- We will be using these texts to work on the following I CAN's...
  - I CAN ask and answer "wh" questions to show and understand important details in nonfiction text.

## Writing: Narrative

- I CAN write a narrative piece using details with a beginning, middle, and end.
- I CAN use words such as first, next, and then to tell events in order and include actions, thoughts, and feelings.

## Math: Place Value

- I CAN understand the 3 digits of a 3 digit number represent the amounts of hundreds, tens, and ones.
- I CAN read and write numbers to 1,000 using base-ten numerals, number names, and expanded form.
