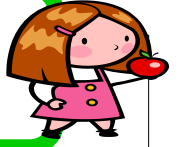




# Ms. Mikrut's Newsletter

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## Our Learning This Week:

**Reading:** Students earned their detective badges this week for completing all of the secret missions! Students will continue to be word detectives throughout this new unit. Students also were assigned new reading partners based on their new first grade reading level! Raz kids will also be adjusted so that students can log in any time at home to practice. Students have also been learning about different types of non-fiction text features in books about sharks and polar bears.

**Writing:** Students completed Unit 1! We will have a celebration with the other first grade classes to share their writing!. This week, we also started a new unit on "How-To" ideas. Students will be learning about how to tell someone how to do something.

**Math:** Students have been focusing on finding out how that when there is two of the same numbers (6-6, 8- 8, etc.) it always equals 0. They also learned about -1 facts, such as 9-8=1, 7-6=1, etc. Next weeks, student will be able to notice how addition facts are related to subtractions facts by using a variety of strategies such as number sentences, pictures, and addition charts.
