Grand Prairie is proud to help collect pop tabs for the Ronald McDonald House of Chicago & Northwest Indiana. These pop tabs help provide resources and a place to stay for families who have children that are in the hospital for an extended amount of time. Over the last four years, Grand Prairie has donated over 500 lbs. of pop tabs! They are so grateful for our generosity and encourage us to keep collecting this upcoming school year.

If you choose to help collect, any aluminum can with a tab on it (Doesn't have to be just a pop can) is considered ok to donate. Simply remove the tab and store them in a plastic bag, old coffee can, milk jug, or juice bottle. Once your child has filled their container, have them bring it to school and the PE teachers will store them till the end of the school year. Once the school year is complete, we deliver the pop tabs to the Ronald McDonald House in Oak Lawn, IL. There is no need to count the tabs! Pop tabs are determined by weight, and our school collected over 110 lbs. last school year!

Please consider donating to such a great cause. This is a great life lesson to teach your son or daughter about helping others in need.
