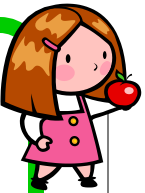

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Our Learning This Week:

Reading: This week, we really focused on finding the characters, setting, and major events in different stories. This week, we made a flip book for the story *Fireflies*. 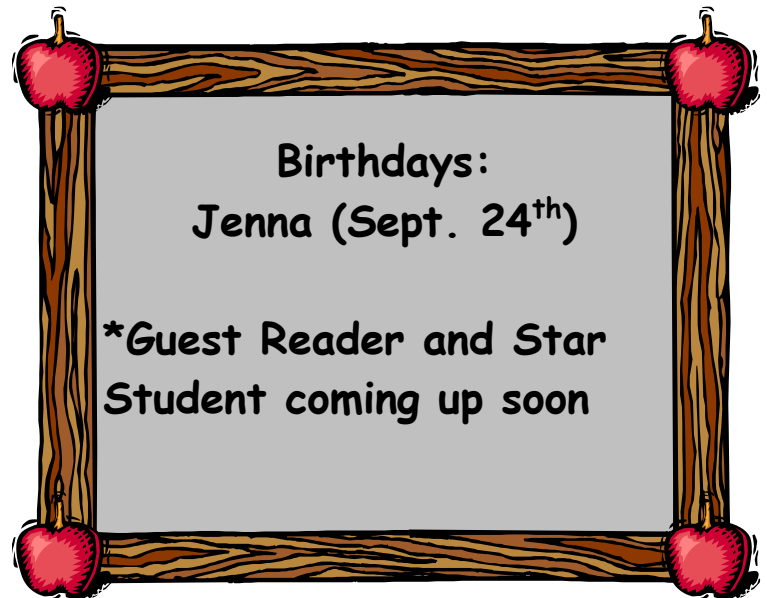
Math: This week in math, students have been learning about the meaning of the equal sign, the commutative property, and looking for patterns. For commutative property, they learned that $5+3=3+5$ and how it equals the same. They found patterns, such as $1+0=1$, $1+1=2$, $1+2=3$, $1+3=4$, etc. Starting Monday and Tuesday, the students will have their first math assessment for module 1.
