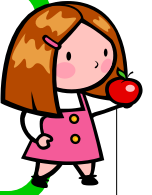

## Our Learning This Week:

**Reading:** We just finished our first ELA assessment! Students took an assessment on characters, setting, and determining a main event from two different stories. Next week, we will learn about different features of a text, like captions, photographs, labels, headings, etc. During reading workshop, students learned about being a good reading partner by helping, not telling the word when their partners get stuck!

**Writing:** This week, students learned craft moves from an author by using pop out words, action words, and using ellipses to build excitement. Students are working on trying out these moves in their own writing! Next week, is the last week of narrative writing!

**Math:** Students completed their first module 1 assessment for math! They will be coming home next week for you to look over and celebrate your child's hard work! This week, we also began subtraction and word problems. They also used number paths to show how to hop up or down and find the quickest path to solve a problem.
